Farm News

Phew--it has been a crazy couple of weeks at the farm! Our to-do list is long this time of year, but thanks to our amazing crew, we are continually checking things off of it! This past week we transplanted our tomatoes, peppers, eggplant, zucchini, yellow onions, and one variety of leeks. This week we plan to transplant more leeks, red onions, yellow squash, cucumbers, melons, and celery. During the much needed rain last week, we also were able to spend the day in our greenhouses planting winter squashes, broccoli, and more cucumbers. We are continually scouting our crops for the presence of pests and diseases. One particularly pesky pest that we look out for are flea beetles. These tiny, hopping insects feed on the leaves and stems of young plants, causing serious injury. In order to combat this pest, we are trying floating row covers for the first time. These row covers, made of a thin material that lets water and sunlight through but not bugs, are laid on top of transplants as soon as they are in the ground.
